Senior Pictures

Congratulations on the success of your child. We here at the WeLiSaHi yearbook staff plan to make the year a success and capture each special moment for every senior. We also would like to make sure that all seniors appear in the yearbook and the class composite picture, however, we have experienced problems with senior pictures in the past. The main areas of difficulty were with deadlines and particular demands of the look of the picture.

This year the school contracted with *Wang Digital Imaging* in Columbus. In order to achieve a unified yearbook and class composite, the staff at the WeLiSaHi annual is requesting all seniors have their picture taken on Thursday, October 27, here at school. This is similar to the portrait packages that are sold to underclassmen. Only pictures taken on this day will be used in the class composite which hangs in the hallway of the school. No substitution can be used. Also, if you are interested, you can order more of these pictures for your personal use as an economical substitution for senior pictures.

The portrait taken on this picture day is the one that will appear in the class composite; however, each senior may bring in an alternate picture for the yearbook provided that it meets the following criteria:

1. head and shoulders shot only
2. no props
3. plain background
4. primarily facing forward (2/3 body position or more)
5. no name stamping on the picture
6. mailed, emailed or handed in to the yearbook staff by Christmas break

If the criteria for the alternate pictures is not met the portrait that is taken on picture day will be used in the yearbook. This process will help ensure that our yearbook and composite have a unified, professional look as well as providing that our staff meet its picture deadlines. We hope that this is one more step in providing your child with a quality, lasting memory.
